PLEASE READ ALL OF THE BELOW INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY AND THOROUGHLY.

NOTE - CEC For Life no longer asks lay people to maintain individual memberships. On the Feast Day, each church is expected to take up an offering for CEC For Life from the congregation. The offering, your church membership, and your clergy dues should then be sent in together.

FEAST DAY INSTRUCTIONS - PLEASE READ.

- Please **thoroughly read the Letter to the Rector** and prayerfully consider how to best communicate the information concerning the **Feast Day of Our Lord the Giver of Life** to your congregation.
- Copy and reproduce the Donation Cards to include in your Sunday Bulletin or Handout **TWO WEEKS BEFORE** the Feast Day.
- On the Feast Day (which always falls on the third Sunday in January), we ask Churches and Clergy to make their **annual membership commitment** to CEC For Life (see Fee Chart) as well as take up the **annual offering** for CEC For Life from their congregation.
- We also ask that you **preach on the Sanctity of Life on Sunday**, and encourage your people to remain steadfast in building a Culture of Life.
